WHEREAS within the 12 days of action to eliminate violence against women, from November 25th to December 6th, actions were held throughout Quebec;

WHEREAS as local government, there is a need to support efforts made by the Group of housing for women who fall victim to conjugal violence and housing members to sensitize citizens against conjugal violence;
