CADASTRAL OPERATIONS

The Director general presents the draft by-law and gives a summary of the by-law and informs Council about the adoption procedure.

It is proposed by Councillor Peter MacLaurin And unanimously resolved by all councillors:

TO ADOPT the French and English versions of By-law (635-2022) modifying By-law (607-2020) temporary control limiting cadastral operations in order to respect future orientations of the new urbanism plan to limit the application for the exception of suspending cadastral operations as follows:

By-law 635-2022

modifying By-law (607-2020) temporary control limiting cadastral operations in order to respect future orientations of the new urbanism plan to limit the application for the exception of suspending cadastral operations

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The By-law limit the application for the exception of suspending cadastral operations stipulated in Article 9 of By-law (607-2020) regarding temporary control for cadastral operations of less than five (5) lots which does not implicate the opening of new roads.

CONSIDERING Article 112.2 of the Act respecting Land use planning and development (RLRQ., ch. A-19.1);

CONSIDERING resolution 288.09.20 regarding temporary control dated September 9th, 2020;

WHEREAS THAT in September 2020, the municipal council began the process of preparing the redesign of the urbanism plan and every other regulation regarding this matter in order to update the Municipality's major orientations as well as the regulations governing urbanism and land development;

WHEREAS THAT Council intends on limiting the increased density throughout the territory in certain areas of the Municipality;

WHEREAS THAT the realization of a subdivision project in compliance to the by-laws in effect may compromise accomplishing Council's strategic vision and new orientations regarding development on the territory;

WHEREAS THAT a notice of motion was given by Councillor Peter MacLaurin at the regular meeting of March 9th, 2022;

WHEREAS THAT the draft by-law was presented at the regular meeting of March 9th, 2022;

WHEREAS that a presentation of the draft by-law was made by the director general;

CONSEQUENTLY, the municipal council decrees the following:

CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

- 1. **Preamble** The preamble forms an integral part hereof.
- 2. **Goal** The goal of the present by-law is to allow the compromise of accomplishing and realizing the municipal council's new orientations regarding the development of territory and urbanism;
- 3. **Objective** The by-law's objective is improve By-law (607-2020) regarding temporary control limiting cadastral operations in order to respect future orientations of the new urbanism plan with the addition of a limitation to the application of the exception of suspending cadastral operation included in the By-law.

It also aims once again allowing the municipal council to benefit from the time needed to complete the preparation and adoption of the new urbanism plan which will replace the one in effect since 2007.

CHAPTER 2: AMENDING PROVISIONS

4. Addition of a condition for exceptions regarding cadastral operations – Article 9 is modified with the addition of the following paragraph, after the 2^{nd} paragraph : \ll The first two paragraphs apply if the specified cadastral operation is less than five (5) lots and does not involve the opening of a new road. \gg
