Considering resolution 39.02.08 must be modified pursuant to a mutual agreement with the property owner:

It is proposed by Councillor Claude Philippe Lemire And unanimously resolved:

That the resolution read as follows:

- The Municipality take the property as is;
- 2. The Municipality intends taking possession of the property upon signature;
- 3. Mrs. Robillard will have until August 15th in order to move the shed and recuperate her garden;
- 4. The Municipality concedes a right of first refusal to Mrs. Robillard should the Municipality decide to sell the property;
- 5. The purchase price is \$38,427.

#### 181.06.08 HERITAGE CANADA

Considering the Heritage minister notified the Municipality that the Government did not intend to contribute financially to the Canada Day festivities which will be held in Morin-Heights on June 28<sup>th</sup>;

Considering that this event held in Morin-Heights, is the most important in the region which celebrates Canada's birthday;

Considering that last year, the Municipality was made aware that Heritage Canada would modify its criteria in order to allow for the holding of such activities in the days surrounding July 1<sup>st</sup>;

Considering this event is being prepared for the twenty-eighth consecutive year by volunteers of the community and the choice made to hold this activity on a Saturday aims at bringing together family life and volunteers;

It is unanimously resolved:

That Council denounce this absurd decision and ask that Honourable Josée Verner, Minister of Canadian Heritage, status of women and official languages and Minister for La Francophonie to urgently revise her civil servants' decision to refuse financial assistance to the volunteers' committee.

That Council ask that the MRC des Pays-d'en-Haut's council of mayors support Morin-Heights, the only bilingual municipality in the region, in its quest to obtain recognition from the Canadian Government to hold Canada Day on a Saturday.
