Main services available:

- obtain forms and get assistance to complete them:
- submit a request for a birth certificate or to obtain a copy of a birth, marriage, civil union or death certificate (including payment and validation of required documents, when requested):
- general information about certificates and copies of birth, marriage, civil union or death certificates.

Obtaining your birth certificate is very important; this document can be required to:

- travel abroad or request your first passport;
- apply for government allowance and benefits;
- obtain important documents:
- register a child un to a daycare or school;
- register to a college or university.

Certificates or copies of marriage, civil union, or death are also useful documents required for administrative purposes.
