Considering Mr. Timothy Watchorn declared having notified his employer of the present procedure and declares that he will not intervene in the company's dossiers which implicate the Municipality;

It is proposed by councillor Leigh MacLeod And unanimously resolved by all councillors:

That Council adopt the following procedure with regards to all dossiers implicating the Municipality and the company 9129-6558 Québec Inc. - known as David Riddell Excavation / Transport, which is attached to the contractual management policy forming an integral part hereof:

Consequently, Mayor Timothy Watchorn cannot participate in the decision process in any dossier implicating his employer, 9129-6558 Québec Inc. - known as David Riddell Excavation / Transport.

1. The Department heads must produce a written note to the Director general as soon as the name 9129-6558 Québec Inc. - known as David Riddell Excavation / Transport:

2.
