Whereas By-law 489-2013 – Code of ethics and good conduct for elected representatives of the Municipality of Morin-Heights must consequently be modified;

Whereas a notice of motion of the present by-law was given by Councillor Peter MacLaurin at the regular council meeting held on August 10th, 2016;

Whereas the draft by-law was adopted by resolution 218.08.16 at the meeting of August 10th, 2016:

THAT THE PRESENT BY-LAW BE STATUED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1 PREAMBLE

The preamble forms an integral part of the present by-law. **ARTICLE 2**

Article 6 **DISCRETION AND CONFIDENTIALITY** is modified with the addition of a second paragraph to be read as follows:

« It is prohibited for any of the municipality's council members to announce, at the time of a political financing activity, the undertaking of a project, the conclusion of an contract or the granting of a grant by the Municipality, unless a final decision regarding this project, contract or grant has been previously taken by a Municipality's competent authority.

A council member that employs personnel from a firm must make sure that its employees respect the restriction indicated in the first paragraph. In the event of non-respect of said restriction by one of these, the council member is responsible for tax sanctions stipulated by Law.

Whereas, consequently, By-law 496-2012 Code of ethics and good conduct for employees of the municipality of Morin-Heights must be modified;

WHEREAS a notice of motion of the present by-law was given at the regular meeting held on August 10th, 2016 by Councillor Jean-Pierre Dorais;

Whereas the draft by-law was adopted by resolution 219.09.16 at the meeting of August 10th, 2016;

THAT THE FOLLOWING BE STATUED AND ORDAINED BY THE PRESENT BY-LAW:

ARTICLE 1 PREAMBLE

The preamble forms an integral part of the present by-law.

ARTICLE 2

Article 8 **DISCRETION AND CONFIDENTIALITY** is modified with the inclusion of the second paragraph to be read as follows:
