HOW TO PLACE BULKY ITEMS FOR PICK-UP

- Only place **accepted** items for pick-up (see list on reverse side)
- Bulky items must be placed by the street the night before the scheduled pick-up
- Make sure bulky items are visible for pick-up teams
- Items placed in bags or boxes will not be picked-up
- Cut bigger items into smaller pieces when possible

BULKY ITEMS

Bulky items are picked up 4 times a year

CLEAN PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- ✓ Newspaper, flyers, magazines
- ✓ Envelopes and paper bags
- ✓ Juice and milk cartons
- ✓ Egg cartons

PLASTIC

- ✓ All containers # 1-2-3-4-5-7 with logo 
- ✓ Lids and bottle caps
- ✓ Plastic bags and wrap placed in a closed plastic bag
- ✓ Cosmetic, food and cleaning product containers

GLASS

- ✓ Bottles and containers of any color (consigned or not)

METAL (INCLUDING RUSTED)

- ✓ Tin cans
- ✓ Foil and aluminum plates
- ✓ Empty drink cans

FOOD RESIDUE

- ✓ Raw, dried, cooked, frozen and expired foods
- ✓ Food leftovers
- ✓ Egg shells
- ✓ Dairy products
- ✓ Meat, fish, seafood (including bones and shells)
- ✓ Coffee filters and tea bags

GREEN WASTE


- ✓ Dead leaves, grass and other garden residue
- ✓ Small branches, sawdust and wood shavings

SOILED PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- ✓ Pizza box
- ✓ Paper plates
- ✓ Tissues and paper towel

OTHERS

- ✓ Hair, fur and feathers
- ✓ Animal food
- ✓ Cat litter clumps

- ✓ Diapers
- ✓ Sanitary products (tampons, sanitary pads...)
- ✓ Vacuum cleaner bags, disposable broom sheets (*Swiffer* type), dryer sheets
- ✓ Cat litter
- ✓ Wax paper and waxed cardboard
- ✓ Light bulbs (except compact fluorescent) 
- ✓ Non numbered plastics
- ✓ Porcelain and pyrex (non salvageable)


- ✓ Furniture
- ✓ Appliances (except refrigerating appliances)
- ✓ Electric devices **No electronic devices**
- ✓ Empty furnaces
- ✓ Hot water tanks
- ✓ Carpet
- ✓ Mattresses and boxsprings
- ✓ Armchairs and sofas

ECOCENTRE

- ✓ Construction, renovation and demolition materials (wood, gypsum, shingles, mineral wool, window glass, etc.)
- ✓ Christmas lights
- ✓ Garden waste (leaves, grass clippings, **except branches**)
- ✓ Tires
- ✓ Metal
- ✓ Refrigerating appliances
- ✓ Computer equipment and electronic devices
- ✓ Car batteries
- ✓ Propane tanks

- ✓ Mercury lamps (energy saving, neon, etc.)
- ✓ Furniture, mattresses and carpets
- ✓ Polystyrene packaging
- ✓ Clean polystyrene food containers (rigide and styrofoam) 
- ✓ Household hazardous waste (batteries, paint, oil, glue, solvent, chlorine, and all products identified with a red octagon and a pictogram inside)

The ecocentre is open to residents and residential property owners from Saint-Sauveur, Morin-Heights, Sainte-Anne-des-Lacs and Piedmont.

The service is also offered to businesses and institutions as long as the materials to be disposed are comparable in type and quantity to those disposed by the residential sector.
