

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## MORIN-HEIGHTS PICKLEBALL PLAYERS



### 1. CONTEXT

The Municipality of Morin-Heights and the volunteer Committee of the Morin-Heights Pickleball Club (the “Club”) are committed to providing a safe and positive environment for pickleball players during free play and Club activities. This code of conduct informs pickleball players of the expectations for respectful and appropriate behaviour during free play and Club activities, whether the player is on the courts or in the waiting areas.

### 2. APPLICATION

This code of conduct applies to all pickleball players:

- who participate in free play
- who are members of the Club
- who participate in any other activities organized by the Club

### 4. RESPONSIBILITIES

Pickleball players agree to:

- i. Respect all players regardless of physical characteristics, athletic ability, age, citizenship, ethnic origin, creed, disability, economic or marital status, gender identity or expression, or sexual orientation;
- ii. Consistently demonstrate a spirit of “fair play” and ethical conduct;
- iii. Ensure adherence to the rules of pickleball and the spirit of those rules;
- iv. Follow the Club’s schedule, the Club’s playing system, and decisions regarding players’ skill levels;
- v. Refrain from any disruptive or violent acts or behaviour, including excessive noise, racket throwing, or the use of profane or offensive language;
- vi. Refrain from any form of harassment.

### 5. CONSEQUENCES

- a. Any player who contravenes this code of conduct may be asked to leave the pickleball courts immediately.
- b. Complaints should be brought to the attention of the Municipality of Morin-Heights.
